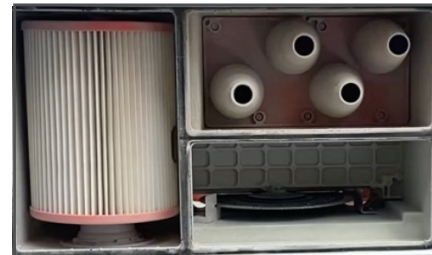

## OPERATING TIPS

- Use appropriate pressure when feeding material into the machine; Too much force can glaze the blade and cause chipping.
- Dressing the blade frequently allows for optimal performance, cutting speed, and blade life.
- Spin the vacuum filter 2-3x per day.
- Maintenance - replace vacuum filter and saw motor brushes annually (\*\*Annual Tune-Up kit available\*\*).
- Saw requires iQ blades, but iQ blades can be used on non-iQ saws by utilizing the included arbor insert.
- The saw does not come with a stand, but can be set on any stable surface.
- Ensure dust guard is manually adjusted to the proper height.



### FILTER AND BLADE MAINTENANCE

Access the filter compartment and blade by removing the dust tray and turning the saw on it's side

## BASIC TROUBLESHOOTING

- **The blade is hot and/or having trouble cutting:**
  - The blade is most likely glazed and or warped. Try using a dressing stone to see if performance improves. If not, replace the blade.
- **The vacuum is not controlling the dust:**
  - Spin the filter and empty the dust tray. If this does not improve the suction, inspect the filter for any damage. If there still isn't suction, call iQ Technical Support.
  - Why do I still see some dust when cutting? iQ saws are not 100% dustless, and a minor amount of dust may be visible while cutting.

### The saw won't start:

- Perform a check of the saw motor brushes to make sure that they are not worn down.
- Check to make sure that the receptacle has power and that a circuit breaker has not been tripped.
- Call iQ Technical Support for further assistance in diagnosing the issue.
